The long awaited 11th album by Scottish born artist Phamie Gow delights us with a collection of some of her positively vibrant and eclectic original works allowing the harp to be heard in a new light. All compositions are by Phamie who sings, plays keyboard, low D whistle and accordion on the album and is accompanied by brilliant musicians such as Fraser Fifield on whistle and saxophone, Tom Richardson on guitar, Mattie Foulds on drums, Javier Villar Morales

on percussion, James
Graham with Gaelic voice
and there is even a
collaboration with DJ
Williams with 'Harp Beats'.
Musical influences range
from Celtic to Indian, Folk to
Breton, Jazz to Hip Hop.
Phamie transcends
boundaries with the genres
that she works with and has

revolutionised this ancient instrument by coming up with new sounds and techniques.

The original album was recorded in analogue at Riverside Studios, Glasgow though with this recording, it has been newly mixed, mastered and edited into a new digital format.
